

## Greek Papyri found outside Egypt

Cf. TURNER, *Greek Papyri* 37–41

COTTON, Hannah M./COCKLE, Walter E.H./MILLAR, Fergus G.B., *The Papyrology of the Roman Near East. A Survey*, JRS 95 (1995) 214–235, are counting 609 papyrus documents from outside Egypt.

See most of all (some in addition to COTTON/COCKLE/MILLAR):

### Palestine

- P.Murabba'ât: most of them 2nd cent. CE
- P.Masada: Papyri and Ostraca, most of them 66–73/74 CE
- P.Babatha and P.Hever: Archives of two Jewish Women, Babatha and Salome Komaise, daughter of Levi, documents written in Mahoza/Roman province Arabia; the women brought these archives with them when moving to En Gedi (Jewish revolt under leadership of Bar Kochba); both early 2nd cent. CE
- P.Jud.Des.Misc. (Jericho) 4–6; 16–19; (Naḥal Hever) 4; (Naḥal Mishmar) 2; (Naḥal Se'elim) 4 und 5

### Syria

- P.Dura: from Dura Europos
- P.Euphrates: Documents from Roman province Syria Coele on papyrus or leather (esp. from Beth Phuraia); 232–256 CE (no. 1–5 = SB XXII 15496–15500).

### Jordan

- P.Petra: 152 carbonized papyri found in a room near byzantine basilica; 6th cent.

### Bactria

- SB XXII 15765: tax receipt on leather; 2nd cent. BCE

### Dacia Superior (Romania)

- two waxed tablets (both sale of slaves): CIL III p. 936–939 no. VI (139 CE); p. 940–943, no. VII (142 CE)

### Lybia

- O.Bu Njem: Latin ostraca; 3rd cent. CE

### Great Britain

- T.Vindol.: Vindolanda (Hadrian's Wall); late 1st/early 2nd cent. CE

### Switzerland

- T.Vindonissa (= C.Epist.Lat. 16–71): first half of 1st cent. CE

## Some important Greek Papyri found in Egypt but written outside Egypt

- P.Turner 22 (142 CE; sale of slave); BGU III 887 (151 CE; sale of slave)

### Myra/Lycia

- BGU III 913 (206 CE; sale of slave)

### Pompeiopolis/Paphlagonia

- SB V 7563 (207 CE; sale of slave)

### Rhodes

- P.Oxy. L 3593 (238–244 CE; sale of slave); 3594 (prob. 238–244 CE; subject not clear)
