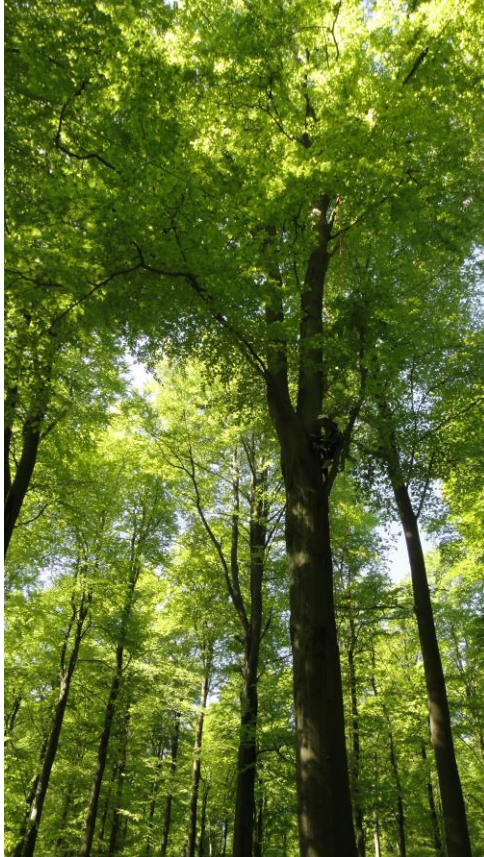


BSc/MSc thesis in Community Ecology



We are offering a BSc/MSc project on predation of terrestrial species on larvae in waterfilled tree holes. Field work will be conducted around Salzburg and/or in other areas of Austria and will use artificial larvae to measure predation rates by birds, small mammals and arthropods on aquatic insect larvae. Within the project there will be room for development of your own ideas.

The candidate should have an interest in community ecology, trophic interactions and data analysis. Ideally the project will begin in the spring of 2019.
