### APPLICATION

To apply for the Young Investigators Award an abstract in German or English of up to 600 words must be submitted (max. 5 references), as well as a CV and (optional) a paper on the topic, the doctoral thesis or a chapter of doctoral thesis. The topic of the abstract must be part of the dissertation (at the university of Salzburg) of the first author. Applicants are either doctoral students at the PLUS or postdoctoral scientists less than a year after graduation.

Award winners from previous years are excluded from the competition. Ongoing dissertation projects can only take part in the competition if an approved disposition and initial results are available.
