## Living expenses for international students in Salzburg

Budgeting for living costs is an important part of planning for university life for both regular students (degree seeking) and mobility students. These are the estimated costs, with the lower and upper price ranges, for living in Salzburg. The cost of living can vary greatly depending on your lifestyle, budget and spending habits.

If not further defined, these costs are broken down by month. You can calculate your estimated budget based on how long you will be in Salzburg.

These costs do not include tuition fees.
There may be additional course costs i.e. workbooks for language courses.
