„Multi-patch discontinuous Galerkin space and space-time Isogeometric Analysis “

March 30, 2017

Abstract:

In the first part of the talk, we introduce and investigate multi-patch discontinuous Galerkin (dG) Isogeometric Analysis (IgA) approximations to elliptic heterogeneous diffusion problems. In the second part, we present and analyze new stable single-patch and multi-patch space-time IgA method for the numerical solution of parabolic diffusion problems in fixed and moving spatial computational domains. The research work presented in this talk is a joint work with C. Hofer, S. Moore, M. Neumüller and I.
