**Abstract:**

Many believe that we have reasons to benefit others. It is natural to think that, other things equal, if we have such reasons, we should benefit others impartially and as much as possible. But when are other things not equal? Many believe also that we have reason to give priority to our kin, to our friends and others with whom we have social or political relationships, or to our benefactors. This paper argues that these relationships have no significance in themselves, though there are almost certainly derivative impartial reasons to take them into account. The argument proceeds on the basis of examples illustrating the lack of normative significance in each of these different relationships.
