

1. Students, who want to join and graduate within the DD-Programme, have to, as a precondition, be students at Paris Lodron University Salzburg and have to attend the EUS-Programme.
  2. A group of Students from each University can join the DD-Programme every year. The students do not have to pay extra fees for participating at the Guest University.
  3. The Deadline for applying for the DD-Programme at SCEUS will be made public by the SCEUS every year. Interested students are welcome to apply and will be informed if they are viable for a study place.
  4. The candidates will be nominated by the SCEUS Coordinator (until December 31<sup>st</sup> respectively June 30<sup>th</sup>) and Palacky University Olomouc will be informed about their future students.
  5. As soon as study places in the Double-Degree Programme are confirmed, students are advised to apply for the Erasmus Programme (Infos at the International Office) – caution Erasmus-application Deadlines may differ.
  6. No later than one month before the stay, all relevant documents will be requested from the DD-Students have to arrive at the Guest University.
  7. The DD-Students have to fulfill administrative preconditions; those have to be in accordance with the national law.
  8. The student is liable to register, in order to become a regular student at Palacky University Olomouc. The application has to be submitted on February 15<sup>th</sup> at the latest (at the law faculty at Olomouc University) of the particular academic year, in which the Master-examination takes place at the University of Salzburg.
  9. The students have to attend and complete courses according to the requirements of the Palacky University Olomouc as well as the EUS curriculum at the University of Salzburg. Details are given in the EUS curriculum and from the international office of Palacky University. Upon others, students have to attend the following courses (if not attended already at the home University):
    - Policy System of the Czech Republic (4 ECTS)
    - Introduction to the Studies of Law (3 ECTS)
    - Introduction to Constitutional Law (5 ECTS)
    - Introduction to Administrative Law and Administration (6 ECTS)
    - Private international law of EU (5 ECTS)
    - Human rights protection mechanisms (4 ECTS)
- Other courses, up to the minimal threshold of the requested ECTS, can be chosen from the current offered course list at the law faculty, or can be coordinated and discussed with the coordinator at the law faculty in Olomouc. **Students are advised to discuss their choice of courses with both coordinators before the semester starts!**
10. The master thesis has to be (co-)supervised from an authorized Professor at the Guest University.

11. The students have to successfully defend their master thesis and pass the examination. After those requirements, students will receive the title "MA" and get the DD-diploma. To receive the Degree of the Palacky University several documents (the Salzburg diploma, transcript of records and a diploma supplement) have to be sent there in time, they can be requested and picked up at the examinations office (Prüfungsreferat) of Salzburg University.
12. Any costs concerning the study visit (travel costs, stay, etc.) have to be paid by the students themselves.
